

# **PRIVACY NOTICE**

#### Data base for Media releases and News

Stadler is a system provider of mobility solutions in railway vehicle construction, service and signalling technology. This Privacy Notice informs you about the processing of personal data by the company of the Stadler Group listed below (hereinafter referred to jointly as "Stadler", "we" or "us") in connection with your subscription for Media releases and News.

# 1. Controller and data protection officer

All Stadler companies with an internal public relations (PR) departments are jointly responsible for processing your personal date in connection with the data base for Media releases and News, which is why a corresponding contractual agreement has been concluded which regulates the obligations regarding data protection between each other as follows:

# 2. Data processed, purpose of data processing and its legal basis

Your contact details (surname, first name, company, e-mail address, if applicable telephone number and company address) will be included in our database for Media releases and News in order to regularly send you media releases, news and event invitations (for selected recipient groups). Your consent serves as the legal basis for processing.

#### 3. Transfer of data to third parties

The following third parties can access your data:

- Our e-mail service provider Mailchimp in the US
- Our Stadler internal PR departments

If and insofar as we use a third party for the performance of a contract with you, your personal data will only be disclosed to the third party to the extent that this is necessary for the corresponding performance

If data is transmitted to a country that does not have an adequate level of data protection, the data will be protected accordingly, in particular by means of standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission and recognised by the Swiss Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner (FDPIC).



## 4. Retention period

Your data will be deleted as soon as you unsubscribe from receiving media releases and thus withdraw your consent to the said processing of your data. You can find the link to this as well as the contact for the PR department responsible for you at the bottom of every media release.

#### 5. Your rights

To the extent provided for by applicable data protection law, you have the right to request access to your personal data, to require that your data be rectified or completed, to have processing restricted or data erased, and to receive your data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format in order to transmit this data to another location (data portability).

Furthermore, you may object to the processing of your personal data if we are not obliged to process it for the performance of a contractual or legal obligation. If processing of your data is based on your consent, you may, at any time, withdraw it. Please note that the withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of previous processing.

Your rights may be restricted, in particular if the exercise of your rights conflicts with the performance of our legal or contractual obligations, or where we can demonstrate an legitimate interest in processing, or the rights of third parties would be infringed.

If you believe your rights have been infringed, you may, at any time, lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority. In Switzerland, this is the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner
