Enrolment for the Job Subscription

This Privacy Notice informs you about the processing of personal data as part of your registration for a job subscription by the company of the Stadler Group listed below (hereinafter "Stadler", "we" or "us").

2. Data processed, purpose of data processing and its legal basis

We process personal data that you yourself provide to us via the input mask on the website (e-mail address, first name, last name, title, desired occupational field, level, place of work). We process your personal data to send you the desired job offers on the basis of your consent.

3. Transfer of data to third parties

We will only disclose your data to a third party if this is necessary to achieve the purposes mentioned or to protect our legitimate interests or to comply with the law. The third parties with whom we share data (or who may have access to data through their services) include, but are not limited to service providers of IT services in Switzerland and Europe.

If and insofar as we use a third party for the performance of a contract with you, your personal data will only be disclosed to the third party to the extent that this is necessary for the corresponding performance.

4. Retention period

We keep this data until you withdraw your consent to receive Job Subscriptions by unsubscribing from the Job Subscription. You can do this by clicking on the link contained in every job email.

5. Your rights

To the extent provided for by applicable data protection law, you have the right to request access to your personal data, to require that your data be rectified or completed, to have processing restricted or data erased, and to receive your data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format in order to transmit this data to another location (data portability).

Furthermore, you may object to the processing of your personal data if we are not obliged to process it for the performance of a contractual or legal obligation. If processing of your data is based on your consent, you may, at any time, withdraw it. Please note that the withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of previous processing.
